3.	Proper Ventilation		Ensure vents are clear and functioning to avoid CO buildup.		No venting is required, but ensure proper airflow around the unit.
4.	Keep Combustibles Away		Maintain a safe distance from curtains, furniture, and other flammables.		Keep away from water sources and ensure proper ventilation.
5.	No Flammable Liquids or ltems		Store flammable liquids or items away from the fireplace.		Keep away from liquids, especially in bathrooms or kitchens.
6.	Safety Screen or Barrier		Use a safety screen to prevent burns, especially for children or pets.		lt is not necessary, but keep children away as a the unit produces heat.
7.	Pilot Light Monitoring		Regularly check the pilot light. If it goes out, follow relighting procedures via the manual.		Not Applicable.
8.	Gas Leaks		lf you smell gas, evacuate immediately and call your local gas company or utility.		Not Applicable.
9.	Overheating Protection		Ensure manual shut-off systems are functional.		Ensure the fireplace has an automatic shut-off feature.
10	. Turn Off When Away or Not In Use		Always turn off the gas fireplace when leaving or going to bed.		Unplug or switch off the fireplace when not in use shut-off feature.
11.	. Childproofing		Use child safety screens or childproofing features found on the app or remote control.		Utilize childproof settings through app or remote, if available.
12	. Regular Cleaning		Clean the glass and components regularly to avoid buildups.		Clean vents and the exterior of the unit to avoid dust buildup.
